\*for all people who find this time of year stressful and a cause for anxiety

\*for the many tragic situations around the world of poverty, disease, natural

disasters and human catastrophes. May all those who are suffering find relief and hope for a better future.

\*for our medical services, our hospital and all who are suffering delays in diagnosis and treatment as well as all suffering from Covid 19 across our island.

\*We remember those on our Island who are homeless and sleeping rough; those who face fuel and energy deprivation. We give thanks for Graih and the IoM Food Bank, and Women's Refuge, and we hold them before God that they may be supported in the work they do to look after the vulnerable in our community.

\* We hold before God the humanitarian crisis on the border between Belarus and Poland where thousands of men, women and children are caught up as pawns in a political battle, suffering in freezing conditions, with no shelter or provision or hope of the situation being



quickly resolved. We pray for compassion, for the opening up of the area to Aid agencies that people's basic needs may be met, for positive political dialogue that will deescalate the rising tension. We pray for those who are working, illegally, at grass roots level to bring help and comfort, peace and unity, that their work may be blessed.

From amongst our own fellowships, we continue to pray for those we know to be ill, suffering the frailties of age or disease, friends or family awaiting treatment or operations and those recovering from accident or illness, as well as the lonely, grieving and the anxious. May they know God's presence and peace.
